# Ground breaking event 15 March 20204 in Kafaraj, Fier-Summary report about media coverage and outreach

# Summary overview

The major objective for planning this event was to reach maximum national TV coverage and maximum outreach on social media and YouTube.

## Live streaming

Therefore, we hired a company offering live coverage of the event, with three cameras, live editing, and live streaming of the event. The event was streamed through the Facebook Channel of the Ministry of Infrastructure and Energy and henceforth it was live broadcasted by 10 TV stations with national coverage. Those 10 TV stations can be considered to be the most important ones.

The stream was provided through the "Facebook" account of the Ministry of Infrastructure and Energy, and has been viewed directly in this channel by 8.300, 1.100 likes, 125 comments and 213 shares.

## **News reports**

In addition all material was available to all TV stations for editing their own news reports. All TV stations produced news on the event, with the usual length of between 1:20 min and a bit over 2 min. In total the airings of these news, which were repeatedly broadcasted by several TV stations, sums up to a total of about 67 min airing time.

## Audience / Outreach

Referring to outreach and audience: The four major TV stations reported in total about 84,200 viewers of their live newsstream. Looking at the news reports on YouTube, there have been 3,195 views of all the 10 news reports from the TV stations.

# Messages / correctness of information

All texts of the news have been transcribed and analysed. Information is widely correct, with some exceptions. In some cases there has been missing information about all donors, and some facts have not been transmitted in a few news reports. In all cases, 'WPIP' has not been mentioned – all news reports talk only about 'Municipal Investment Programme V'. We will analyse in detail the findings and consider in future communication.

## Text:

The Deputy Prime Minister, Belinda Balluku, at the same time Minister of Infrastructure, presented the launch of the "Municipal Infrastructure V" program, dedicated to new investments in the water supply and sewerage network in some of the main cities of the country such as Shkodra, Lezha, Elbasani, Fieri, Berati and Vlora.

This program is financed by the German Government, through the KfW, the Swiss Government, the European Union and the Albanian Government.

"Through the deep reform, the indicators have started to improve, collections have increased, work is also being done to collect the debits carried over the years, but also to raise a more efficient staff. Currently, there are 33 urban areas and 98 rural areas across the country that are supplied with high quality drinking water 24 hours a day. Meanwhile, through investments, their number will increase at the end of this year. With the 2024 budget and all other program packages, we anticipate that 13 urban areas will be added to the list of areas benefiting from high-quality, 24-hour drinking water, bringing the number to 46 urban areas, and 45 rural areas. bringing the number to 143 rural areas served 24 hours with water, 9 of which are tourist areas", said Balluku.

About 266 kilometers of new water supply network, 17.4 kilometers of new sewage network, 14 thousand new connections and rehabilitation of existing connections, as well as about 13 thousand new installed meters will benefit from this program.

Investments in all cities will serve a population of about 470 thousand inhabitants with a new water supply network.

During this year, through the reform of the water supply sector, it is also intended to reduce the level of uninjected water, increase the financial performance of companies and reduce the number of party jobs.

The municipal infrastructure program 5, which envisages investments in the water supply network in several cities of the country, has started today from Fieri. Cooperation with the German government in this program has been emphasized by the Minister of Infrastructure and Energy for a duration of 12 years.

For the minister, the water supply sector, although there has been a positive progress, still needs work.

For 2023, we had a significant improvement. The number of workers per 1000 connections in 2023 has reached 4.6 and compared to 2020 it has been 5.23. We have 33 rural villages and 98 urban areas that are supplied with high quality drinking water according to parameters 24 hours a day.

More than 1 million Albanians benefit from this project, over 40 percent of the population is affected by these changes. The project focuses on the improvement of the drinking water supply system, the sewerage of polluted water and their treatment in several municipalities of the country.

Deputy Prime Minister Belinda Balluku emphasized from Fieri that the challenge this year remains to increase the areas that are supplied with drinking water 24 hours a day.

Currently, there are 33 urban areas and 98 rural areas across the country that are supplied with high quality drinking water 24 hours a day. Meanwhile, through investments, their number will increase at the end of this year. With the 2024 budget and all other program packages, we anticipate that 13 urban areas will be added to the list of areas benefiting from high-quality, 24-hour drinking water, bringing the number to 46 urban areas, and 45 rural areas bringing the number to 143 rural areas served 24 hours with water, 9 of which are tourist areas.

Deputy Prime Minister Belinda Balluku stated that the challenge of the water and sewerage system remains the improvement of the financial situation.

"We had 62%, we will manage to go to 59%, that is, a significant reduction of water without income. During the year 2023, a great focus has been given to the increase of invoicing and collection. As a result of the action against informality, there has been a significant improvement of 10% in the collection rate. :

The municipalities that benefit from these interventions in the water and sewerage system are Shkodra Lezha, Elbasani, Fier, Berati and Vlora. The investments will be made with the support of the German KfW and the Swiss Embassy.

#### **Text**

125.6 million euros is the value of the investment in the water supply - sewerage sector that will start in 6 municipalities of the country. The investment will be focused on the areas of Shkodra, Lezha, Elbasan, Fier, Berat and Vlora, while the value is divided between a loan of 80 million euros from the German Kf and grants given by the European Union, Switzerland and Germany.

During the ceremony for the presentation of the "Water Sector Performance and Investment Program - Program V for Municipal Infrastructure", the Minister of Infrastructure and Energy, Belinda Balluku announced that investments in this sector are expected to increase the 24-hour supply of water in rural areas. and urban ones.
